The Government operates a scheme called Gift Aid. This is a simple scheme that allows your chosen charity to claim back the basic rate of tax that pay from the government.

Gift Aid will have the effect of giving us an extra 20% of the donation at no extra cost to our donors.

- You can cancel this declaration at any time by contacting the charity.
- You must pay an amount of income tax and / or capital tax at least equal to the tax that the charity reclaims on your donations in the tax year (currently 28p for each £1 you give).
- If in the future your circumstances change and you no longer pay tax on your income and capital gains equal to the tax that the charity reclaims, you can cancel your declaration.
- If you pay tax at the higher rate you can claim further tax relief in your self-assessment, tax return.
