1 FUNDRAISING

Fundraising can be hard. We know that it doesn't come naturally to everyone but that doesn't mean it's impossible! We hope that you will try to raise as much money as possible to empower education in Sierra Leone. Below you will find some fundraising tips and tools.

FUNDRAISING PLATFORM

EducAid have joined Wonderful, a fundraising platform that truly is wonderful. They believe that charities should receive every penny raised by supporters and volunteers. We love their commitment to honour the fundraising efforts of all of you!

Setting up a Wonderful fundraising page is the quickest and easiest way to collect your sponsorship donations. It is very easy to set up a fundraising page on Wonderful, but if you would like help then please read our guidance document, which has step-by-step instructions. If you need more support please feel free to contact us.

SPONSORSHIP

This is the most commonly used fundraising technique, and it requires very little from you! Simply set up a fundraising page, ask your family and friends to sponsor your run and tell them you're running for EducAid Sierra Leone. Easy.



MARKET YOUR TRAINING

Take your sponsorship further and ask people to pledge money for each mile you run in training! Friends and family could pledge as little as 10p for each kilometre you run before the 21st of July.
